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A24 Ashington to Southwater Case Study

In connection with the proposed £35M upgrade of the A24 Ashington to Southwater, Transport Planning International (TPI) commissioned Streetwise to conduct a number of surveys.

Proposals include closure of 28 central crossings and accesses and are planned to improve the accident rate on the route.

Surveys included junction turning counts (JTCs), queue length and delay surveys and journey time monitoring.

Junction turning counts and queue surveys were conducted by video with subsequent office based enumeration.

Journey time surveys were undertaken by GPS allowing standard timing points and subsequent analysis of speed across different sections of route as required.
